Hope this monthly letter finds you all doing well. Here are some updates from Goshala BJ Animal care.

1) YOUR DONATIONS AT WORK!

a) Monthly Hay and Grains delivered

Thanks to your donations we were able to deliver monthly food supplies in the goshala.





b) Junk/Debri removal from goshala- Over the years, a lot of trash and debri had been dumped inside and around the goshala grounds. Another effort was made to clean up goshala. Majority of accumulated debri has been removed from the goshala grounds in the past few months.







c) Removal of invasive species- Dense weeds, prickly & thorny bushes are a ground reality in open grasslands and a big deterrent for cow's grazing and the goshala visitors. We have begun their removal process from the goshala grounds to sustain healthy pastures for cow's grazing plus smoother interactive experience for visitors alongside the pasture's fencing.

Here's the broad list of areas that we need help on:

A) 'Behind the scenes' Goshala volunteer activities

We need a team of individuals volunteering which includes the following but not limited to:

- Researching grants via corporate grant management program- 5 people
- 2) Grant writing proposals on behalf of our animal welfare organization 5 people
- 3) Volunteer database management including record keeping of volunteer hours for kids, teens and adults. Tallying volunteer hours every quarter, signing off volunteer hours log for high schoolers, designing volunteer certificates & issuing certificates.- 5 people
- 4) Outreach- online outreach via WA groups, networks groups and in person meetings plus at the special community events- 10 people.

B) Hands-on in Goshala -volunteer activities includes the following:

- a) broom goshala floors,
- b) removing plastic & trash,
- c) removing weeds around fences,
- d) washing cow's accessories & ropes,
- e) washing black dish pans,
- posting banners,
- g) showering cows,
- h) organizing the goshala's garden tools and inventory,
- i) organizing Goshala's hay pantry,
- interacting with cows and younger calves to establish comfort with humans.
- k) Scooping Gobar
- scrubbing water bins

- m) installing water controllers on 2 more pastures, running water tubing, testing controlling, programming their functions and setting up bins for automatic water throughout the day.
- n) Educating visitors about side effects of sugary Food donations
- Installing new hay bins, refilling current hay bins, labeling hay bins for visitors to use for feeding cows.
- Redirecting visitors to feed hay to cows instead of unhealthy, fat-increasing foods from home.
- q) Goshala posters in various cities Grocery stores and restaurants.
