Hope you are all safe amidst of extreme weathers on both coasts. California had also been dealing with floods, arising from winterstorms. Goshala got flooded too but Heartiest Thanks to your donations, contractors were hired during stormy weathers to drain flood waters out of cow's living areas.



Aloe Vera garden space has been created in goshala. Cows' urine(gomutra) collection pits have been revived and connected via drainpipes to irrigate the Aloe Vera Garden. Cow's urine(gomutra) has high levels of nitrogen much needed by garden beds. Aloe Vera plant is very helpful for cows' digestive system, plus it is used it as a herb in treating many ailments and infections.





January 18th was an unfortunate morning in Goshala with a tragic loss of baby calf. One female baby calf Rukmini was found lying lifeless in the morning and rushed to the Vet hospital. Unfortunately, Calf didn't make it:-(

Reasons-Nobody knows yet but doctors at UC Davis Veterinary hospital are working on to ascertain the cause. We will keep you updated as more information becomes available in coming days.
